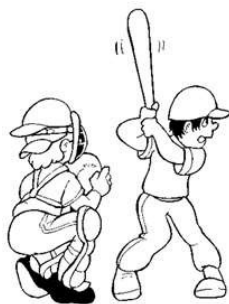
We are also excited that Kennett High School now has a sanctioned JV Girls team competing this year with sights set on a full varsity program in the near future.
