Cook Memorial Library ~ On Wednesday, September 14th at 7:00 at the Cook Memorial Library, a program titled Tiny Houses: A Very Different Approach to Home Ownership will be presented. The talk focuses on the basics of planning for and owning a tiny house on wheels; both its challenges and advantages. It offers insights unique from the currently popular tiny house themed TV shows, from approximately "how much" and "where to live", to the efficient use of space and the management of composting toilets.
